Weekly update:

Paper pencil work – It is very important to stay current on your assignments and turn them in weekly to be graded. This is not the time to get behind on assignments. The school year is quickly coming to a close and the amount of time you have to complete assignments is also getting shorter.

Dr. Noeth asked me to mention that there are too many students who have “Incompletes” in ProgressBook at the high school. There are two reasons for the “Incomplete” grade. Students either have missing assignments or they are failing the class. It is important to remember that students have until May 4 to correct the incomplete grade. After May 4, the incomplete will become a letter grade.
