Board Policy 5517.01 requires, at least semi-annually, the Superintendent to provide to the President of the Board a written summary of all reported incidents and post the summary on the District web site (if one exists). The list shall be limited to the number of verified acts of harassment, intimidation, and/or bullying, whether in the classroom, on school property, to and from school, or at school-sponsored events. This letter serves as my report for the first semester of the 2016-2017 school year, second semester of the 2016-2017 school year, first semester of the 2017-2018 school year, second semester of the 2017-2018 school year, and first semester of the 2018-2019 school year.

Harassment, intimidation, or bullying means:

- A. any intentional written, verbal, electronic, or physical act that a student or group of students exhibits toward another particular student(s) more than once and the behavior both causes mental or physical harm to the other student(s) and is sufficiently severe, persistent, or pervasive that it creates an intimidating, threatening, or abusive educational environment for the other student(s); or
- B. violence within a dating relationship.
