 Resolution Declaring Intent to Proceed With Election of the Question of an Emergency Tax Levy (10 Years)

(R.C. Sections 5705.03, 5705.194 - 5705.197)

WHEREAS, on January 14, 2019, the Board passed a resolution (the "Resolution of Necessity") declaring the necessity, in order to provide for the emergency requirements of the School District, to levy a tax in excess of the ten-mill limitation, to raise \$1,750,000 for each year that said levy is in effect, for a period of 10 years, and upon the entire territory of the School District; and

WHEREAS, the County Auditor of Logan County, Ohio has certified to the Board that an estimated annual levy of 6.2 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which is sixty-two cents (\$.62) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, will be required to produce the annual amount set forth in the Resolution of Necessity.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of the Bellefontaine City School District, Logan County, Ohio, a majority of the members of the Board concurring, that:

Section 1. The Board desires to proceed with the submission of the question of such additional emergency tax levy (the "Emergency Levy") to the electors of the School District.

Section 2. The question of the Emergency Levy shall be submitted to the electors in the entire territory of the School District at the election to be held on May 7, 2019 (the "Election Date"). All of the territory of the School District is in Logan County, Ohio.

Section 3. The form of the ballot to be used at said election shall be substantially as follows:

Shall a levy be imposed by the Bellefontaine City School District, Logan County, Ohio for the purpose of providing for the emergency requirements of the School District in the sum of \$1,750,000 and a levy of taxes to be made outside of the ten-mill limitation estimated by the county auditor to average 6.2 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to sixty-two cents (\$.62) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for a period of 10 years, commencing in 2019, first due in calendar year 2020?

FOR THE TAX LEVY
AGAINST THE TAX LEVY

Section 4. The Treasurer of the Board is hereby directed and shall certify, not later than February 6, 2019 (which date is not less than 90 days prior to the Election Date), to the Board of Elections of Logan County, Ohio a copy of the Resolution of Necessity and a copy of this resolution, together with the amount of the annual tax levy expressed in dollars and cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation, as well as in mills for each one dollar of valuation, as estimated by the County Auditor of Logan County, Ohio.

Section 5. The Treasurer of the Board is hereby directed and shall certify to the Board of Elections of Logan County, Ohio that the Emergency Levy will run for a period of 10 years and that the Emergency Levy will include a levy on the 2019 tax list and duplicate (2020 collection year) if approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon.

Section 6. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22.
